CANDIDATE BRIEF/JOB OVERVIEW

With support from Meath Local Sports Partnership, Cricket Leinster is looking to engage a Development Resource/Coach in the Meath area on an initial short-term contract assignment focussed primarily on schools in the Navan and Ashbourne catchment areas.

This programme is being undertaken on a pilot basis in collaboration with our two local clubs – Knockharley Cricket Club and Ashbourne Cricket Club with the objective to broaden the reach of cricket in Meath, to introduce cricket to a wider audience and to support our local clubs in the ongoing development of sustainable youth playing structures.

This role seeks an energetic and enthusiastic individual who has a passion for supporting and developing people, and working with multiple schools and local organisations. The role combines coaching and development work and will be responsible for engaging young people across Meath into becoming active members of the local clubs.

You will need to be passionate about, and committed to, cricket development at a local level and for this role, it would be an advantage if you have experience of cricket/sports development at a grassroots level coupled with a sound knowledge, appreciation and understanding of the game.

Candidates must demonstrate both team working skills and the ability to work unsupervised using their own initiative. You will be a self-starter with energy and enthusiasm together with good administration and organisational skills. Equally you will be an excellent communicator with a passion for the development of cricket/sport for young people.
